

# Fremont County Building & Environmental Health Departments

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## **PERMITS CANNOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION & MATERIAL PROVIDED BY THE APPLICANT**

- If your property lies within 400 feet of the sanitation district we will not issue a permit. Any questions, please call Fremont Sanitation @ 269-9050.
- Address of Property.
- Soil profile (evaluation) provided by a registered professional engineer – @ least 8 feet deep.
- Septic tank size determined by a registered professional engineer.
- Percolation rate determined by a registered professional engineer.
- Determination of registered professional engineer as to suitability of the site for an absorptive waste water system.
- Plot plan indicating perc sites, profile test hole, & all pertinent features (ditches, gullies, buildings, etc.)
- Flood plain information for specific site. Specific construction criteria as designed by a registered professional engineer if site in flood plain.
- Specific construction techniques designed by a registered professional engineer if soil conditions dictate special construction.
- Engineer must inspect & certify to Fremont County any engineer designed system installation (mound, soil replacement, etc.) prior to county inspection being conducted & called for.
- Lot size.
- Absorption area.
- Number of bedrooms.
- Indicate if dwelling will have washer & garbage disposal.
- Source of water.
- Detailed map of property depicting driving route from highway 50 with street names & distances if applicable.
- Owner of property.
- Owner's mailing address & telephone number.
- Type of building by use. (Residential, Commercial, etc.)
- Plat date.
- Slope of the ground @ proposed leach bed site.
- Address must be posted on property visible from a public roadway @ time inspection is called for.
- Fremont County permit fee & use tax must be paid @ time of application.
- All engineering documents must be wet stamped, signed, dated & the construction address listed on each page by the engineer. Non-compliant documentation will not be accepted.
- Owner will be responsible for all above requirements.
