RED→CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are more likely than other violations to contribute to illness or environmental hazards that may contribute to a disease outbreak. Critical item violations include inappropriate diapering procedures, lack of handwashing, ineffective sanitization and disinfection, ill personnel preparing food or caring for children, unsafe water supply or sewage disposal, vermin infestation, food temperature abuse and uncontrolled toxics.

BLUE→NON-CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are not directly related to the cause of illness, environmental hazards or disease outbreak, but if uncorrected, could negatively affect the operation of the child care facility. These include a lack of facility cleanliness and poor maintenance of equipment and facilities.

The kitchen is temporarily closed and will remain closed until repairs have been completed in the kitchen (replace all floor covering and base cabinets) and a re-inspection conducted to approve the kitchen to re-open.

There was a sewer line backup on Thursday, June 4, 2009 and I conducted a field visit at that time. The operator of this child care had voluntarily closed the facility and the children were being sent home.

A cleaning company came Thursday to begin the clean up and continued through the weekend. The child care reopened this morning but the kitchen will remain closed. Food is being catered in from the Gooseberry Patch Restaurant and everything is single-service disposable for serving food.

A voluntary condemnation form was completed for food items that were in the kitchen at the time of the sewer back-up.
