04 d	KITCHEN-(4-302) The end of the spray hose hangs down into one of the 3-compartment sink basins. Use the hook to keep the end of the spray hose up and out of the sink when not in use.		
04 d	CUSTODIAN'S CLOSET-(4-302) The end of the hose attached to the mopsink faucet hangs down into the sink basin, the faucet is not equipped with a vacuum breaker.		
04 e	POOH BEAR & CATERPILLAR RESTROOM-(4-405)-The spindels are missing from the toilet paper holders in the toilet stalls, toilet paper not in holders.		
06 h	COOKIE CLASSROOM-(6-210)-Wet sand used in the plastic pool in the classroom is not changed daily. Dry sand can be changed once weekly, wet sand or other wet media should be changed daily.		
07 b	KITCHEN-(7-101) Thermometer missing in one kitchen refrigerator.		
07 d	7-101-On the food carts going to the individual classrooms, the large perforated serving spoons are in the utensil holder with the food-contact ends sticking up.
