RED→CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are more likely than other violations to contribute to illness or environmental hazards that may contribute to a disease outbreak. Critical item violations include inappropriate diapering procedures, lack of handwashing, ineffective sanitization and disinfection, ill personnel preparing food or caring for children, unsafe water supply or sewage disposal, vermin infestation, food temperature abuse and uncontrolled toxics.

- ↳ Corrective Action: Corrected On-Site. Correct-By: 07/27/2009
Inspector Comments: 6-201 Person in the kitchen was wiping and drying hands on apron rather than using paper towels.

06j. Sanitizer/Disinfectant Use

- ↳ Corrective Action: Corrected On-Site. Correct-By: 07/27/2009
Inspector Comments: 6-202(c),(d) In Room #4, sanitizer strength bleach water in spray bottle (200 ppm) is use for both sanitizing and disinfecting.

BLUE→NON-CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are not directly related to the cause of illness, environmental hazards or disease outbreak, but if uncorrected, could negatively affect the operation of the child care facility. These include a lack of facility cleanliness and poor maintenance of equipment and facilities.

- ↳ Inspector Comments: 2-103(a) Dumpster lid open.

02b. Swimming Pools/Wading Pools

- ↳ Inspector Comments: 2-201(b) Standing water in 2 inflatable wading pools on the playground; wading pools are not placed in storage between uses. Standing water in a water activity table on the playground.

- ↳ Inspector Comments: 2-201(b) Could not locate a pool test kit to test free chlorine residual when wading pools are in use. Free chlorine is required to be between 0.4-2ppm. Note-Water in the wading pools is required to be between 77-90 Deg.F when in use by children. Test kit must measure free chlorine, not total or combined chlorine. The city water supply may already be at 0.4ppm free chlorine, but you need a test kit to check and to know when you have to add chlorine to the wading pools to maintain the proper level.

06k. Sanitizer/Disinfectant Test/Store



Inspector Comments: 6-405 No chlorine test papers to measure disinfectant-strength bleach water (test concentrations between 500-1000ppm). Regular chlorine test papers will measure between 0-200ppm.



Inspector Comments: 6-406(b) Spray bottles of bleach water in some classrooms are only labeled as "Bleach Water" and not labeled as sanitizer or disinfectant depending on the strength of the bleach solution. Spray bottles of bleach water are also not labeled as to their intended use such as sanitizer/toys & tables, or disinfectant/restrooms & diaper change tables, etc.
