RED→CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are more likely than other violations to contribute to illness or environmental hazards that may contribute to a disease outbreak. Critical item violations include inappropriate diapering procedures, lack of handwashing, ineffective sanitization and disinfection, ill personnel preparing food or caring for children, unsafe water supply or sewage disposal, vermin infestation, food temperature abuse and uncontrolled toxics.

BLUE→NON-CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are not directly related to the cause of illness, environmental hazards or disease outbreak, but if uncorrected, could negatively affect the operation of the child care facility. These include a lack of facility cleanliness and poor maintenance of equipment and facilities.

Inspector Comments: 3-103(h), Carpet on the floor under the handsink in the Toddler Room. At the next convenient opportunity, eliminate the carpet on the floor under and surrounding the handsink.

06k. Sanitizer/Disinfectant Test/Store



Inspector Comments: 6-406(b), Bleach water solution in kitchen is labeled "Kitchen" but not labeled as "Bleach Water".



Inspector Comments: 6-406(b), In the Infant Room, the disinfectant in the spray bottle is not properly labeled.



Inspector Comments: 6-405, No disinfectant test papers to measure disinfectant-strength bleach water in the 500-1000 ppm range.

Inspector Comments: 7-101, The top surface and the edges of the island countertop are damaged, edge covering is missing.



Inspector Comments: 7-101, Some particleboard shelves are not painted or sealed. Seal or paint all surfaces, top, bottom and the edges.



Inspector Comments: 7-101, Some fluorescent lights in the kitchen are not operating.

07d. Prohibited Foods/Activities



Inspector Comments: 7-101, Open beverage container in kitchen. Food handlers may have beverages in the kitchen as long as the beverage is in a covered container.



Inspector Comments: 7-101, The table-mounted can opener is dirty.
