RED→CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are more likely than other violations to contribute to illness or environmental hazards that may contribute to a disease outbreak. Critical item violations include inappropriate diapering procedures, lack of handwashing, ineffective sanitization and disinfection, ill personnel preparing food or caring for children, unsafe water supply or sewage disposal, vermin infestation, food temperature abuse and uncontrolled toxics.

BLUE→NON-CRITICAL ITEM VIOLATIONS are not directly related to the cause of illness, environmental hazards or disease outbreak, but if uncorrected, could negatively affect the operation of the child care facility. These include a lack of facility cleanliness and poor maintenance of equipment and facilities.

- ↳ Inspector Comments: 6-406(b) In classroom #6, bleach water sanitizer bottle is empty, spray bottle is not labeled as to use, such as "Sanitizer/toys & tables".
- ↳ Inspector Comments: 6-405 Sanitizer test papers are available for bleach water sanitizer but there are no disinfectant strength test papers available.
- ↳ Inspector Comments: 6-406(b) In classroom #8, bleach water in spray bottle is not labeled as sanitizer or disinfectant (it tested as sanitizer strength, aprox. 200 ppm). Label as sanitizer or disinfectant and label for intended use.
